Peggy Coady Receives President's Award for Distinguished Teaching



Those who know Peggy Coady, B.Comm. (Hons.)(Co-op) '90 and MBA '97, will not be surprised to learn that she is the youngest recipient of the President's Award for Distinguished Teaching. Ms. Coady began teaching accounting full-time at Memorial's Faculty of Business Administration in 1997. Since then, she has won numerous awards including the Dean's Award for Teaching and the students' Professor of the Year. She has also been noted in MacLean's magazine Guide to Universities as one of Memorial's 'Popular Profs'. In addition to teaching and pursuing a PhD from the University of Bath in the UK, Ms. Coady is coaching the MBA team that will compete in the 2005 Concordia Cup Competition.

Ms. Coady was awarded both the University Medal for Excellence in Business Administration and the University Medal for Excellence in an All-Course Masters Programme. Her list of accomplishments as a student also includes such distinctions as Sobey Scholar, winner of the Concordia Cup, Dean's List recipient and Fellow of the School of Graduate Studies. She articulated with Deloitte & Touche LLP and received the Chartered Accountant designation in 1993.
